- 13. Board to hear an update on the loss of its excavator, possible remedies from DWR, and possibly purchasing an excavator for the District.

Project Funding Agreement TW-21-1.2, Project Funding Agreement for the Planning, Engineering, and Construction of the Twitchell Island Wetland Enhancement and Restoration Project (TIWERP) (Expires 12/31/2027). The Board will hear a status update and discuss. The Board will review and consider awarding to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder of the TIWERP Plant Procurement contract.
- 15. Project Funding Agreement TW-24-1.0-SP Phase 2 of the Multi-Benefit Project. The agreement with DWR will improve District levees. (Expiration December 31, 2028). The Board will hear a status update and discuss. The Board will consider approving a resolution accepting Sevenmile Slough PEA.
- 16. DWR Agreement "Subsidence Mitigation Funding Agreement" (SMFA) (Wetland Development/Subsidence Reversal and Carbon Sequestration Project) (East End and Rice Project) (SMFA Expires 12/31/2030). The Board will hear a status update and an update on the need for the project equipment.

 - I. DWR System Wide Multi-Benefit Project Funding Scoop of Work.
 - A. Report on progress of project for activities aimed at addressing erosion-induced damages to the levee waterside slopes and levee roadways along Sevenmile Slough between levee stations 166+50 and 170+50 on Twitchell during the 2023 high water event that DWR is considering funding as part of an Emergency.
 - B. The project will qualify for a CEQA Categorical Exemption (CE) and the District will file a Notice of Exemption (NOE) which has a 35-day posting time. Due to biological habitat on site, the district will need to apply for a California Department of Fish & Wildlife (CDFW) Lake and Strem Bed Alteration Agreement (LSAA) permit, which typically takes 4-6 months to acquire. The Project qualifies for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Section 404 Maintenance Exemption and therefore, no permit or schedule is required for that.
